### Description:

This 18-hole, par 72 course, has been named as one of the most beautiful golf courses in the world. This tricky, wind-swept course offers stunning views, unique natural hazards and challenging greens. With nine holes bordering the Caribbean and nine that snake through verdant hillsides, Tryall offers stunningly diverse topography.

The signature par-three 4<sup>th</sup> hole incorporates the natural challenges of the Caribbean Sea and the Flint River, while the memorable par-four 7<sup>th</sup> hole provides a dramatic tee-shot through the stone pillars of the historic aqueduct that feeds the adjacent waterwheel. The Tryall Club has played host to such prestigious international events as the Johnnie Walker World Championship, last won at Tryall by Fred Couples in 1995.
